

Sr Chief Jim Wise USN (Ret.) spoke with great detail about his Pearl Harbor experiences


Sr.Chief Jim Wise as he experienced "Pearl Harbor Remembrance Dinner" - a thrilling experience for him, and his daughters:



All the survivors had captivating stories and Captain Lam delivered a tremendous address.




Pizza, Pizza



Pentagon Puts Out Call for Swarming Attack Drones That Could Blunt a <u>Taiwan Invasion</u>

The U.S. military has taken the next step in building thousands of lethal sea-borne attack drones that could be key to deterring a Chinese invasion of Taiwan. On Monday, the Defense Innovation Unit put out a solicitation for companies to submit pitches for small unmanned surface vehicles that could tie into the Pentagon's Replicator initiative, a defense official confirmed to USNI News on Tuesday. DIU's PRIME - Production-Ready, Inexpensive, Maritime Expeditionary - will buy drones in bulk to respond to a Navy operational need for small autonomous attack craft capable of "intercepting" enemy vessels at high speeds
